

**UPPER OXFORD TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION
FEBRUARY 3, 2020**

The Upper Oxford Township Planning Commission held their monthly meeting at the township building, 1185 Limestone Road, Oxford, PA at 7:00 PM on Monday, February 3, 2020.

Members present: Elizabeth Randolph, Colin Kraucunas, David Underwood, Harold Bryson and township secretary, Jane Daggett.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by the Vice Chairman, David Underwood

MINUTES – Motion was made by Elizabeth Randolph, seconded by Harold Bryson and carried to approve the January 6, 2020 Minutes. MOTION CARRIED.

AMOS ESH PLANNING MODULE – This module was reviewed by the UOT Planning Commission at their October 1, 2019 meeting and was signed off by the Chairman, Karl Herr. Motion was made by Harold Bryson, seconded by Elizabeth Randolph and carried recommending that the Amos Esh Planning Module be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for review and approval. MOTION CARRIED.

CHRIS STOLTZFUS PLANNING MODULE –The Township received Component 4B from the Chester County Planning Commission. This module was reviewed by the UOT Planning Commission at their December 3, 2019 meeting and signed off by the Chairman, Karl Herr. We are waiting for approval from Chester County Health Department.

WOODLAND CLASSIFICATION MAP – A map was presented to the Planning Commission which was prepared by Brandywine Conservancy for West Bradford Township to show as an example of what can be done. Supervisor Rugen explained to the Commission that this opportunity was presented to the Oxford Regional Planning Committee. Lower Oxford Township, Elk Township and West Nottingham Township along with Upper Oxford expressed a desire to have Brandywine Conservancy prepare a woodland classification map for them. The cost would be shared by the municipalities interested and grant money would be available through the County. The map would show acreage along with classifications of the woodlands. Time frame for this service would be a few months.

STOP THE BLEED TRAINING – Supervisor Rugen mentioned that the township road crew attended a Stop the Bleed Training and learned how to apply a tourniquet. Supervisor Rugen handed out some pamphlets on the matter to the audience and Planning Commission members.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, motion was made by Harold Bryson, seconded by Elizabeth Randolph and carried to adjourn at 7:30 PM.
