MINUTES – Motion was made by Dave Underwood, seconded by Elizabeth Randolph and carried to approve the February 6, 2023 Minutes with the following changes:

Historic Commission – insert "Commission" at the second line. "Blair Fleischmann was present and discussed with the Planning Commission members the Historic <u>Commission</u> Draft Ordinance which was presented to them last month".

DE STORAGE – The Planning Commission will recommend to the Board of Supervisors that the accept and grant an extension until June 3, 2023 for review of the land development plan.

The Planning Commission encouraged Mr. Stoltzfus to contact the Alliance for Chesapeake Bay if he was interested in a 50' stream buffer instead of the 35' buffer he initially said would be put in. Ron Ragan will contact Regester in references to making the needed changes to this plan.

DISCUSSION – was held regarding solar panel zoning and also the outreach efforts of Gaye Lynn on behalf of Chester County Conservation District.
