The purpose of the work session was to meet with the HOA and make them aware of the on-going problems and issues that face the Grist Mill Development. A corrugated pipe starting across from 4 Grist Mill and continuing approximately 200 feet is disintegrating. This pipe will need to be replaced. Supervisor Rugen gave a brief synopsis of the problems. In January a sink hole appeared and the Township received a complaint from DEP. The farmer who owned the adjoining field was cited and put in grassy strips at the bottom of the field to help with erosion. Approximately three (3) years ago, the Township installed a box to help with water ponding. The Township will work with the HOA in order to help find a solution to replacing the damaged pipe. The Township is not responsible for anything outside of the right-of-way. One suggestion was to look into grants from DEP to find some funds available to help with this project.

There being no further business, the work session adjourned at 8:30 PM.
