Upper Oxford Township Board of Supervisors held an advertised work session at the township building, 1185 Limestone Road, Russellville, on Monday, September 26, 2022 at 7:00 P.M.

The work session was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by the Chairman, Scott Rugen.

CHESTER COUNTY MODEL STORM WATER ORDINANCE – We are waiting for the township engineer to provide the finalize draft of the ordinance. Comments from the Planning Commission members and Supervisors were forwarded to the engineer to include in the draft. Areas of discussion were regarding High Tunnels and how to calculate them and also procedures if they are grandfathered. Scott reported that he tried to find a stand-alone High Tunnel Ordinance and will contact Brandywine Conservancy to see if they have any samples. DEP requires all submissions by 2023.

NEWSLETTERS ARTICLES – Scott wrote an article about Home Improvement Contractors. Blair Fleischmann submitted an article about Imaging related information at Chester County Historical Association. Scott informed the other that we can use a few items from DEP regarding Storm Water Management in our newsletter.
