Upper Oxford Township Board of Supervisors held an advertised work session at the township building, 1185 Limestone Road, Russellville, PA on Monday, March 23, 2026 at 7:00 P.M.

The work session opened at 7:00 PM by the Chairman, Scott Rugen. Items of discussion are as follows:

HYDRA TERRA – The Supervisors voiced their concerns to Hydra Terra regarding going forward with the project and re-applying for a grant. Last year, our grant that was submitted to help with our Act 537 was denied. Kimberly believes if we would be able to get more support from our elected representatives it would make a difference. Funds are available. Time period is usually a year however. Hydra Terra explained how the tracking of sewage pump out would work. All haulers would need to be registered with DEP, CCHD and Hydra Terra within the Terra Tracker system. An ordinance would need to be enacted and a 2M Component would need to be completed. Newsletters could education our home owners. Pumpers would only have access to reports showing only the properties which they pumped. Approximately cost would be \$25,000 which includes legal fees and grant work. The deadline for the next grant is May 31st. This will be placed on the April agenda.
